Descriptive Citation This is a citation method that says in the text leading up to the quotation what source the quotation is from and where in the source it is from.

8. In-text citations are citations placed after a direct quote, paraphrase, or summary. The author's name needs to appear either in the signal phrase or in the in-text citation at the end. In APA, you will need to put the year and the page number in your citation. In MLA, you will need to put just the page number. Note the comma usage in APA.
