MMSEA Section 111 Medicare Secondary Payer Mandatory ...

Direct Data Entry, or DDE, is the simplest method of reporting MMSEA Section 111 data. DDE reporting is done through the Section 111 COBSW. DDE is designed for smaller RREs that don't expect to report much claim information under Section 111 (i.e., less than 500 claim reports per year).
