## Description, Systems, & Note Symbols ...

The earliest form of musical notation can be found in a cuneiform tablet that was created at Nippur, in Babylonia (today's Iraq), in about 1400 BC. The tablet represents fragmentary instructions for performing music, that the music was composed in harmonies of thirds, and that it was written using a diatonic scale.

Transition to modern staff notation. Indications for loud and soft arose early in the century, expressed as words (forte, mezzoforte, piano) and later as abbreviations ( f, mf, p ). Graphic signs for dynamic and attack (staccato dot, crescendo mark, for example, and also phrase marking) appeared in the 18th century.
