Skill Training in Affective Regulation (STAIR) is an 8-session individual treatment for a variety of patients with PTSD. STAIR includes skill building in emotion management and social skills that can be used as a stand-alone therapy or as a complement to trauma-focused therapy (e.g., PE, CPT).

Narrative therapy separates people from their problems, viewing them as whole and functional individuals who engage in thought patterns or behavior that they would like to change. 3. Narrative therapy views the client as the expert. In narrative therapy, the therapist does not occupy a higher social or academic space than the client.
