In Naturalistic Inquiry, Lincoln and Guba "[contrast] postpositivist and naturalist paradigms on philosophical and methodological dimensions." The major naturalist axioms include: Realities are multiple, socially-constructed, and holistic (ontology). Knower and known are interactive, inseparable (epistemology).
