Guide Number = distance x f/stop Number. This takes the Inverse Square Law into account. So at GN 72 and f/16, direct flash exposure is $GN 72 / f16 = 4.5$ meters. Or the other way for example, GN 72 / 8 meters is f/9. This applies only to the same flash head zoom that the original GN 36 was for.*
