DOCUMENT MARGINS. Rule: Papers submitted for review or grading should have 1" margins all around. This should be the default for Word, but if your default setting is to have left and right margins of 1.25", change your default. Page length requirements are based on 1" margins.

The default margins for Microsoft Word from version 2007 onward have been 1 inch (25.4 mm) all around; in Word 2003, the default top and bottom margins were 1 inch (25.4 mm), but 1.25 inches (31.7 mm) were given at the left and the right.
