It turns out that confidence can go a long way! For example, if you know the answer to one question is "A," you can assume that the next answer will not also be "A." He also says the longest answer on multiple choice tests is usually the correct one, as the test makers typically need to use more words to ensure the correct answer cannot be disputed.

Through his data, Poundstone found following probabilities in case of multiple-choice questions: On tests with three choices (say, A, B, and C), all the options were equally likely to be correct. On tests with four choices (say, A, B, C, and D), B was slightly more likely to be correct (28%).
