A "paddle shift" transmission refers to any of the following where gears can be selected by pulling/pushing on paddles/buttons manually without the use of a clutch pedal: a classic torque converter automatic transmission which can be operated in manual mode, an automated single clutch transmission where the clutch engagement/disengagement is controlled by a computer, and the very popular dual clutch transmission where clutch engages/disengages also is controlled by a computer.
