Roots anchor plants in the ground and absorb water and nutrients. Stems support the plant body, transport materials, and produce leaves and other organs. Leaves absorb sunlight, conduct photosynthesis, and exchange gases with the air. They have adjustable pores that let gases in and out of the leaf.
