The poverty guidelines are a simplified version of the federal poverty thresholds used for administrative purposes — for instance, determining financial eligibility for certain federal programs. They are issued each year in the Federal Register by the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS).

The poverty guidelines issued here are a simplified version of the poverty thresholds that the Census Bureau uses to prepare its estimates of the number of individuals and families in poverty. As required by law, this update is accomplished by increasing the latest published Census Bureau poverty thresholds by the relevant percentage change in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U).

For instance, the guidelines issued in January 2017 are designated the 2017 poverty guidelines. However, the 2017 HH poverty guidelines only reflect price changes through calendar year 2016; accordingly, they are approximately equal to the Census Bureau poverty thresholds for calendar year 2016.
