Ask children to describe what the problem is. Help children to reframe the problem so it is defined as their problem, not someone else's problem. For example: "I want to use the red crayon," instead of, "they won't share the red crayon." Step 3: Come up with Solutions. Encourage children think of as many solutions as possible.
