Pennsylvania and many other states require all non-petroleum professional geologists to either work under a licensed Professional Geologist or a Professional Geologist (P.G.) license. Thus, if you want your career to advance beyond 'flunky', you will need to take the P.G. licensure exam. If you plan to be a petroleum or academic geologist, you do not need to worry about becoming a P.G.
