RACGP - Curriculum

The RACGP develops resources and guidelines, advocates for GPs on issues that affect their practice, and develop standards that general practices use to ensure high quality healthcare.

RACGP - Guidelines for general practice

For any case-based submission, authors must ensure informed consent is obtained from patients discussed or depicted in the manuscript, or their legal representatives. The RACGP 'Patient consent' form provides a template for ensuring informed consent and must be completed and retained by the author and the patient or their legal representative.

RACGP - AAA screening and surveillance

Diagnosis A minimal trauma fracture of the hip or spine in a person older than 50 years of age is presumptive of osteoporosis (Recommendation 1 A). Treatment may be initiated without confirmation of low bone mineral density (BMD). Use BMD to guide management after fracture at other sites.

The Royal Australian College of General Practitioners (RACGP) recommends against PSA screening, but acknowledges that the PSA debate remains unclear and open to individual interpretation. 7 The Prostate Cancer Foundation of Australia and Cancer Council Australia guidelines from 2016 recommend PSA testing every two years for men aged 50–69 years at average risk of prostate cancer. 8 This recommendation is supported by the Urological Society of Australia and New Zealand (USANZ).
