In exchange for fourteen years of labor, Jacob had two wives, Leah and Rachel. Jacob showed favoritism to Rachael and loved her more than Leah.

Leah's story starts in Genesis 29. Jacob's uncle, Laban, had two daughters. Leah, the eldest, had eyes that were "delicate." Rachel, with whom Jacob fell in love, was Laban's younger daughter; and she "was beautiful of form and appearance" (Genesis 29:16-17).Jacob made an agreement to serve Laban seven years for the opportunity to marry Rachel.
