In the reference list, start with the author's last name and initials, followed by the year. The book title is written in sentence case (only capitalize the first word and any proper nouns). While the basic information included in a citation for a book is the same, the format varies among the Modern Language Association (MLA), American Psychological Association (APA), and Chicago citation styles.

If a book has multiple writers, at the start you must mention them all, but you may use 'et al.' afterward: (Maxwell et al.) Sometimes you must cite a source cited in another source. Write The Title of a Book in an Essay Properly According to the Chicago Manual of Style and the Modern Language Association, titles of books (and other complete works, such as newspapers and magazines), should be italicized. So if abiding by either of those guides, you'd italicize Stephen King's *The Shining* , just as you would *Vanity Fair* and *The Miami Herald* (and *Appetite for Destruction* , if your protagonist is a Guns N' Roses fan).
