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Robert Mapplethorpe: the male gaze – in pictures | Culture ...
Lisa Lyon met Mapplethorpe in 1980 and they collaborated on many photography projects including a film as well as a book titled, *Lady, Lisa Lyon* (1983). For Mapplethorpe, Lyon blurred the line between male and female with her strong female form, "When I first saw her undraped it was hard to believe that this fine girl should have this form."
