Model or reference numbers within a particular series of watch (Submariners, say) tend to follow an evolutionary scheme (to wit: the modern Rolex GMT Master II with Pepsi bezel is the 126710BLRO, which sounds like a mouthful — but when you realize that the ref. 16710 was the last generation of the “ Pepsi ” bezel-quipped GMT Master II that Rolex produced before the current one came out, you can see how one reference number evolved into the next one).

So below the reference number is 6538 for Rolex Submariner Big Crown produced between 1956-1959, then below you see I.56, which means it left production at first quarter 1956 and all the way down you see a stamp that has shortly been used around 1956, the 18 which stands for the (high) quality of steel that has been used.

With a different 369 Explorer dial and different movement, the 6200 surely is the odd one compared to the 6204/6205. In other words, Rolex model numbers are normally provided to show the model type of the watch, the nature of the bezel, and the material used. Now, take Rolex 16610 for example.

REFERENCE NUMBER APPEARANCE AND LOCATION. A Rolex reference number is as unique as the fingerprints of its owner. Every Rolex has a different reference number that is located between the lugs of the watch at the 12 o'clock position. Many counterfeit watches have a completely fictitious reference number and some may not even have one.

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
