Ordinarily, if a teacher is passing out the grading rubric (which he or she should do), a student will get the rubric when the assignment is handed over. Typically, a teacher will review both the assignment and the rubric, so students know the types of criteria that must be met and can ask questions if necessary.

In addition to quizzes, rubrics can also be added to graded discussions and assignments. Notes: You cannot use a rubric for grading in quizzes, since quiz scores are calculated based on the number of points assigned to each quiz question. You cannot add a rubric to a practice quiz or ungraded survey.
