A fund that awards scholarships on an "objective and nondiscriminatory basis" is tax deductible for its donors. Scholarship grants awarded by these private foundations are taxable expenditures unless the grant programs meet the requirements for individual grants and receive advance approval from the Service. Company scholarship programs will not qualify if grants are essentially providing extra pay, an employment incentive, or an employee fringe benefit.

Scholarships must be awarded on a nondiscriminatory basis to grantees, and the objective procedures used in the process must be confirmed to gain IRS approval. The IRS also requires the organization to choose grantees who are most likely to succeed at the funded activity and to supervise the scholarship recipients to determine if obligations have been met.
