Seamus Heaney spreads out the poem into nine paragraphs. The language in all nine are about feelings but is harder to understand then "Catrin". Gillian Clarke presents the poem into two paragraphs. One is about the past and the other present. This technique is easier to understand rather than Seamus Heaney's.

'Postscript' by Seamus Heaney is a short, meditative poem that describes a transitory moment by the sea and the sight of swans on a lake. The poem begins with the speaker telling the reader they should take the time to travel to the Flaggy Shore in the northern part of County Clare, Ireland.
