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Simple, Compound, and Complex Sentences (Examples) - 2019

A simple sentence has only one clause. A complex sentence has one main clause and one or more subordinate clauses. A compound sentence has two or more clauses of the equal rank. State whether the following sentences are simple, complex or compound.

Compound Sentences vs. Simple Sentences

A compound sentence allows us to share a lot of information by combining two or more related thoughts

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into one sentence. It combines two independent clauses by using a conjunction like “and.” This creates sentences that are more useful than writing many sentences with separate thoughts. Compound sentences are important because they allow us to shorten the things we say or write.
