2 SOLAS Chapter II-2, Regulation 10.10.4 – Fire fighter’s communication. The wording in the SOLAS Chapter II-2, Regulation 10.10.4 is: For ships constructed on or after 1 July 2014, a minimum of two two-way portable radiotelephone apparatus for each fire party for fire-fighter’s communication shall be carried on board.

SOLAS regulations II-2/1 and II-2/10 - amendments entering into force on 1 January 2020: Introduced by IMO resolution MSC.409(97), and waives the requirement for an approved foam-type extinguisher of at least 135 l capacity, for boilers protected by fixed water-based local application fire-extinguishing systems, may apply to all ships on or after 1 January 2020.

Fire Safety Requirements for ships in SOLAS

Chapter II-2: Construction – Fire protection, fire detection and fire extinction. Since fire is a major safety hazard on board, vessel construction includes methods on how to prevent fire, detecting them and their extinguishing systems. Chapter II-2 contains 5 Parts and 23 regulations. Examples of fire safety provisions include the following:

3.6.10.2 The requirement in regulation 10.5.2.2.2 with respect to foam fire extinguishers of at least 45 L capacity each or equivalent does not apply in respect of a vessel that is not a Safety Convention vessel, is of less than 500 gross tonnage and is engaged on a sheltered waters voyage or a near coastal voyage, Class 2.
