Water Pollution - Grey Parrot
Allow students to brainstorm all the reasons why water is significant. Brainstorming is a "free-thinking" or unedited way to compile a list of ideas from students. Remind students that they do not comment on other student ideas during brainstorming. Students are free to share their ideas and ask questions. The teacher should facilitate the discussion and ensure that all students have a chance to contribute. The teacher should also ensure that the discussion is respectful and focused on the topic.
