Give feedback on assignments - Classroom Help

Include informal writing about the assignment before the final paper is due (see "In-class Writing Activities" for suggestions). Conference with students: If time, see each student individually to help them develop and revise their paper. Make your key contribution here; put a grade and only minimal comments on the final paper.

Sample Report Card Comments for Any Teaching Situation

Students should be able to see a clear correlation among 1) written comments on a paper, 2) the grading criteria for the assignment, and 3) the learning objectives for the course. Thus, before you start reading and commenting on a stack of papers, remind yourself of the grading criteria, the learning objectives, and which aspects of the writing you want to focus on in your response.

Writing comments on student papers is something of an art: it requires a little thought and practice for the comments to be effective--that is, both read and attended to. The following recommendations about writing comments were developed for students in writing and literature classes; however, with a little adjustment, they can be applied to any writing assignment.
