Implementation of Citizenship Amendment Bill 2016 would mean the roughly 100,000 Chakma, Tibetan, and Hajong refugees would have the same right as citizens of Arunachal Pradesh. Over 500 students protested against the Citizenship Amendment Bill 2016 [55] led by the indigenous public of Arunachal Pradesh.
