Clinical Judgement An interpretation or conclusion about a patient's needs, concerns, or health problems, and the decision to take action (or not), use or modify standard approaches or improvise new ones as deemed appropriate by the patient's response.

Kohlberg followed the development of moral judgment far beyond the ages studied earlier by Piaget, who also claimed that logic and morality develop through constructive stages.

The Reflective Judgment Stages. Pre-Reflective Thinking (Stages 1, 2, and 3) Stage 1. View of knowledge: Knowledge is assumed to exist absolutely and concretely; it is not understood as an abstraction. It can be obtained with certainty by direct observation.
