History of Swansea City Swansea Town in 1912 Long before Swansea Town came into being, children had played football on a piece of waste ground on which vetch – a cabbage-like plant used for cow feed – grew wild. Vetch Field, as it became known, was leased by the Swansea Gas Light Company to the Swansea League who laid out clinker pitches.
