The Kings Of Israel And

After Rehoboam reigned three years, the United Kingdom of Israel was divided in two – the northern Kingdom of Israel under Jeroboam, with its capital, first in Shechem, then Penuel, Tirzah, and finally Samaria, and ruled by a series of dynasties beginning with Jeroboam; and the southern Kingdom of Judah with its capital still in Jerusalem and ruled by the House of David.

After the death of Solomon, the kingdom was divided. Ten tribes formed the Northern Kingdom, called Israel; Judah and Benjamin formed the Southern Kingdom, called Judah. The date of the division of the kingdom is approximately 931 BC. The following is a list of the kings of Irsrael and Judah.

Of all the kings of Israel, only Jehoram and Hosea are not mentioned as referred to in the Israelite annals. Of the kings of Judah (after Solomon) only Ahaziah, Athaliah, Jehoahaz, Jehoiachin, and Zedekiah are not mentioned in this regard.

The Kings of the Bible Song

The United Monarchy (Hebrew: מלכות ישראל) is the name given to the Israelite kingdom of Israel and Judah, during the reigns of Saul, David and Solomon, as depicted in the Hebrew Bible. This is traditionally dated between 1050 BCE and 930 BCE.

From 1050 to 930 B.C. a united Israel was ruled by kings Saul (from the tribe of Benjamin), David (from the tribe of Judah), and Solomon. They each ruled for forty years . God himself told Solomon , the last ruler over a united Israel, that the people would split after his death and generate kings from at least two distinct family lines (Jeroboam and Rehoboam).
