Inmates from the prison on Riker's Island receive the dead, shipped to Hart Island on a ferry run by the Department of Corrections.

The monastery occupies a narrow terrace on the southern face of the valley, facing Mount Zion and the Old City walls. Akeldama (also spelt Aceldama, Hekeldama and Hakeldama) comes from Aramaic words meaning Field of Blood. The Gospel of Matthew says Judas repented after betraying Jesus with a kiss at Gethsemane.
