The most well-known indicator in the JCR is the Journal Impact Factor (JIF). This measure provides a ratio of citations to a journal in a given year to the citable items in the prior two years. 2017 Journal Impact Factor (JCR)

The annual JCR impact factor is a ratio between citations and recent citable items published. Thus, the impact factor of a journal is calculated by dividing the number of current year citations to the source items published in that journal during the previous two years (see Figure 1).

How can I find out if a journal is included in the Thomson ...

The impact factor or journal impact factor of an academic journal is a scientometric index that reflects the yearly average number of citations that recent articles published in a given journal received. It is frequently used as a proxy for the relative importance of a journal within its field; journals with higher impact factors are often deemed to be more important than those with lower ones.

Journal Citation Reports - Web of Science Group

The Journal Impact Factor (IF or JIF) is published annually by Clarivate Analytics (formerly Thomson Reuters) in the Journal Citation Reports (JCR) and is defined as the number of citations in the previous year (e.g. 2015 for the IF released in 2016) to the citations to articles published in the preceding 2 years (e.g. 2013-2014), divided by the number of articles published during that time.
