The aims of poor theatre are reminiscent of the theories of Artaud. But Artaud aimed to synthesize the work of the actor with 'rich' technology of noise, light and costume. The writings of Nietzsche, Durkheim and Jung are also frequently invoked as influences on Grotowski, but the practical work of Stanislavsky, Meyerhold and the mime Marcel Marceau seem of more direct importance.

Considered as a whole, *Towards a Poor Theatre* appears as a fully thought-out and precisely composed guidebook presenting the fundamental themes and questions that formed the core of Grotowski's work up to that point.
