Mate (Pilot) to Master of Towing Vessels - 18 months service as Mate; 12 months of experience other than limited local area: 3 months on route (s). 1st Class Pilot or Mate of vessel over 200GRT to Mate (Pilot) of Towing Vessels - Minimum of 30 day of training & observation on route (s); exam as necessary; TOAR or Approved Course.

Requirements for a Master of Towing License Applicants for a USCG Master of Towing License must have 48 months of maritime service on the routes for which they are applying. Eighteen of those 48 months must have been a mate or pilot, with a maximum of six of those 18 hours as a harbor assistant.
