### *Trauma Practice Management Guidelines*

*Fluid resuscitation strategies prior to obtaining hemostasis in patients with uncontrolled hemorrhage, usually victims of penetrating trauma, remain controversial. No fluid resuscitation may lead to death from exsanguination, whereas aggressive fluid resuscitation may “pop the clot” and lead to more bleeding.*

*ACS TQIP Best Practice Guidelines*

*resuscitation based on the overall calculated fluid volume by infusing half of the total volume in the first eight hours from the time of injury. Infuse the second half over the remaining eight*

*Fluids are drugs and should be managed as such. Appropriate early fluid resuscitation in trauma patients is a challenging task. Care should be taken in selecting both the type and volume to promote appropriate perfusion and oxygen delivery, avoiding the adverse effects seen when giving too little or too much.*

*Standard trauma resuscitation as defined by the ATLS course includes infusion of ringer lactate solution, which is a racemic mixture containing two stereo-isomers of lactate D-lactate and L-lactate. Normal saline is also frequently used with lactated ringer for resuscitation in hemorrhagic shock, but it has been associated with hyperchloremic acidosis, when given in large volumes.[ 13 ]*

### *Strategies for Intravenous Fluid Resuscitation in Trauma ...*

*Prehospital trauma care systems reduce mortality in low-resource/remote settings. Delayed resuscitation seems a better option when transport time to definitive care is shorter whereas goal-directed resuscitation with low-volume crystalloid seems a better option if transport time is longer.*

### *Fluid resuscitation in trauma: what are the best ...*

*Very few can be saved. Only prevention can reduce this peak of trauma-related deaths. Second – deaths due to SDH, EDH, Hptx, ruptured spleen, liver lacerations, pelvis fractures, and/or multiple other injuries associated with significant blood loss. Golden hour of care after injury is characterized by the need for rapid assessment and resuscitation.*
