The direction to a point is stated as the number of degrees east or west of north or south.. For example, the direction of A from O is N30°E. B is N60°W from O. C is S70°E from O. D is S80°W from O.. Note: N30°E means the direction is 30° east of north. The bearing to a point is the angle measured in a clockwise direction from the north line.
