- All transfer students must be approved by the Executive Director of TSSAA before participating in any game.
- A student who engages in three or more days of practice - including spring practice - with a high school in which he or she is enrolled shall be ineligible in that sport for 12 months if the student enrolls in another school

without a corresponding change in the residence of his or her parents.

The NFHS permits the coach to view their rules books on up to three unique devices using the same email and password.

TSSAA tweaks pitch count regulations

Coaches must wear their TSSAA-provided credential or pay admission. Only coaches recognized by the member school and TSSAA will be provided credentials. Coaches will sign in participants at each venue. At team events, participants will be admitted as a team only. Hand stamps will be given to allow participants to visit other sites without charge.

The TSSAA Board of Control voted on Wednesday to amend the rule, which went into effect during the 2017 season. Beginning in 2018, the changes in the rule for varsity include: The maximum number of pitches that can be thrown in a game is 120 regardless of the situation.
