The updated periodicity schedule reflects current AAP recommendations for preventive pediatric health care, which are explained in detail in the third edition of "Bright Futures Guidelines for Health ...

The " Recommendations for Preventive Pediatric Health Care ," will be published in the September 2015 of Pediatrics (published online Monday, August 31) and contains a new subheading regarding the ...

### **Periodicity Schedule**

On at least 1 well-child visit educate parents about increased risk of sexual exploitation, and remind them that likely perpetrators are people their child knows and trusts, not strangers. At least once between 1 and 5 years of age, as with discussion in the first year of life, discuss future pregnancy planning and review risk of recurrence of Down syndrome and availability of prenatal diagnosis.

### **Bright Futures**

1. If a child comes under care for the first time at any point on the schedule, or if any items are not accomplished at the suggested age, the schedule should be brought up-to-date at the earliest possible time. 2. A prenatal visit is recommended for parents who are at high risk, for first-time parents, and for those who request a conference.

### **Health Supervision for Children With Down Syndrome ...**

Group well child care. In group well child care, the provider facilitates discussion of child rearing issues with a group of parents of similarly aged children. Two randomised trials have compared the effectiveness of group and individual well child care for infants in the first year of life in households with middle and low incomes.

Physical examination and screening tests are also a part of the well-child visit. Your child's visit may include checking blood pressure level, vision, or hearing. Your pediatrician will do a physical examination, which may include listening to the lungs and feeling the abdomen.

Each child and family is unique; therefore, these recommendations are designed for the care of children who are receiving competent parenting, have no manifestations of any important health problems, and are growing and developing in a satisfactory fashion.

### **AAP Updates Well Child Visit Schedule**

Check the child's vision annually, using developmentally appropriate subjective and objective criteria. Refer the child to a pediatric ophthalmologist or ophthalmologist with special expertise and experience with children with disabilities every 2 years (approximately 50% risk of refractive errors between 3 and 5 years).
