The Parthenon is a temple of the Doric order with eight columns at the façade, and seventeen columns at the flanks, conforming to the established ratio of 9:4. This ratio governed the vertical and horizontal proportions of the temple as well as many other relationships of the building like the spacing between the columns and their height.

The Parthenon frieze is the high-relief pentelic marble sculpture created to adorn the upper part of the Parthenon's naos. It was sculpted between c. 443 and 438 BC, most likely under the direction of Pheidias.

The Frieze. The Parthenon frieze runs around the upper edge of the temple wall. Its relatively small size (3 feet 5 inches tall) and placement (inside from the triglyphs and metopes) made it fairly hard to see from the ground. Unlike the metopes, the frieze has a single
