Harry Houdini, the greatest magician ever produced by America, died in Detroit, Michigan during a national tour. The cause of death officially was peritonitis from a ruptured appendix. His death came nine days after having been punched in the stomach during the Canadian leg of the tour by J. Gordon Whitehead, a McGill University student who was testing Houdini's famed ability to take body blows.

On October 31, 1926 surrounded by his wife and brother, Harry Houdini died. Houdini's funeral was held on November 4, 1926 in New York with more than 2,000 mourners in attendance.
