Windows 8 Metro Apps require screen resolution of 1024x768 or better. On NetBooks often the highest resolution is 1024x600.

When Windows 8 first shipped, apps would run either full screen or in snapped view. Further, the minimum resolution requirement were 1366x768, and snapped applications have a width of 320px and full height. This simplified the design slightly, and as a result, many samples had code like the following (C#):

If you find more keys with the name "Display1\_DownScalingSupported", change values of all of them from 0 to 1 Once finished, close Registry Editor and restart your system. After reboot, right-click on Desktop and select "Screen Resolution" option. Now you should get 1024x768 option in the screen resolution list.
