Writing Paragraphs. In writing, students begin by learning letters, then words, and finally sentences. In time, students learn how to write a paragraph by taking those sentences and organizing them around a common topic.

Good transitions can connect paragraphs and turn disconnected writing into a unified whole. Instead of treating paragraphs as separate entities, transitions can help readers understand how paragraphs work together, reference one another, and build to a larger point.

Paragraphs & Topic Sentences. A paragraph is a series of sentences that are organized and coherent, and are all related to a single topic. Every piece of writing you do that is longer than a few sentences should be organized into paragraphs.

Writing experts recommend paragraphs of no more than 150 words in three to eight sentences. Paragraphs should never be longer than 100 words. Vary the lengths of your paragraphs to make them more interesting. As with sentence length, if all paragraphs are the same size, your writing will be choppy.

Types of paragraphs - Writing strong paragraphs ...

Introduction paragraphs are usually about 5% of your essay word count. In clearly-written sentences, the writer gives some background on the main topic; explains the academic problem and tells the reader what to expect in the rest of the essay. You can follow a basic pattern for writing introduction paragraphs to help you get started.
